# FAI SPORTING LICENSE

Each competitor and team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License valid for the year of the Championship. This license must be registered in the FAI licenses database.

# **COMPETITION RULE**

The championships will be run according to:

- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling Volume F1 Free Flight Edition 2024.
- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling CIAM General Rules Volume Edition 2024.
- FAI Sporting Code General Section and FAI Code of Ethics.

For each class of the Asian-Oceanic Championships for Free Flight Model Aircraft, the reigning Asian-Oceanic Champion has the right (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the championships in that class regardless of whether or not he/she qualifies for the national team. If he/she is not a member of the national team, his/her score will not be considered in the team results.

# **FLYING SITE LOCATION**

Flying site – the field of "Darkhan Noyonii Khudag" approximately 50 km to the east from city of Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. There is an area of at least 7km by 5km of short smooth grass. You can see the flying field on internet by Google-earth software with the pointer **47**°**42'15.40"N, 107**°**20'34.86"E**.

#### COMPOSITION OF NATIONAL TEAM

Hold in each class of F1A, F1B, F1C and F1Q. Each National Federation/National Aeroclub may enter a team consisting of 3 competitors or 4 competitors if at least one is female and a team manager. The team manager may have an assistant. The team flies from one pole. ATTENTION! While the Competitions, entrance into the Start Line area is allowed ONLY to those persons, who passed the official registration (FAI Jury, Competitors, Team Managers, Coaches, Helpers, Supporter, Timekeepers, Event Organizers) and have the registration badge. Moreover, all other persons and visitors should be out of approximately 25-30 m zone.

#### TRAINING AND FLYING FIELD

Training and practice for all the teams and competitors on the flying field could be possible on 17th, 18th, 20th, 22nd and 24th of July.

Note: Motorcycles and cars will be prohibited for chasing models during practice and competitions. Only bicycles will be authorized.

# **AWARDS AND PRIZES**

FAI medals and diplomas as well as FAI trophies will be awarded to the first three in individual and team classification including a team manager.

Organizer will award trophies to the best three individuals and teams as well as countries.

Women are considered for the following awards:

- FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed women only if six (6) or more women are competing. If the number of women' participants is less than this number (six), then only FAI diplomas will be awarded;
- The best woman earns the title of Woman Continental Champion if women from at least four different nations participate in that class and the total number of women are six (6) or more.

Organizers will provide local timekeepers. Each participating country (NAC) is requested to provide one or more timekeepers with its national team. The intention to enter a timekeeper should be announced in Final Entry Form.

# MODEL AIRCRAFT FUEL

Fuel for F1C class will be provided in accordance with CIAM General Rules C.13.8. We will be able to provide with castor oil. Please send order to us in advance.

# DOCUMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

- Competitor's FAI License valid for 2024;
- A copy of team's banking payment receipt or cash receipt on registration site;
- One national flag approximately 120×150 cm;
- One CD or MP3 format with their national anthem;
- Valid FAI certificates for the models.

All models must be processed by their NAC, with FAI certificates and stickers in accordance with CIAM General rules C.12. Model aircraft not properly processed by their NAC with FAI certificates and stickers, will be processed by the organizer at a cost 8 Euro for each model.

# FACILITIES AND SERVICES ON THE FLYING SITE

The following facilities and services will be available on the flying site.

- Lunch package and water for competitors during their competition day (included in entry fee);
- Refreshments and food for sale will be available at the flying field;
- Toilet facilities;
- Medical service.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

Camp hotels are available approximately 5-30 km distances from the competition flying field. Hotel information and online booking can be found on the web site (https://ihotel.mn).

# **INSURANCE**

The Organizer will provide third party insurance cover to all participants for accidents involving injury to others or damage to property according to the host country's legislation. All the participants must have their own health insurance to cover illness and accidents.
